The itinerary to crown the top begins with the forest track that gives access to the public estates of Son Fortuny and Sa Coma d'en Vidal, going up to the recreational area of Boal de Ses Serveres. Throughout the climb we will be able to enjoy the spectacular views of the Estellencs coast, and with a bit of luck, we can spot a booted eagle (Hieraaetus pennatus).

At the top we can visit the ruins of the small observatory where astronomer Dominique François Aragó lived until 1808, where he worked to establish the measurement of the arc of the earth's meridian between Catalonia and the Balearic Islands.

We can alternate this route going back down the Comella de Ses Sinies descent and then turning towards Puig de Galatzó, going down the Pas d'es Cosins for a different and unique alternative.
